Instrumental Music Enrolment Agreement

The Instrumental Music Program (IM) provides tuition on Woodwind, Brass, Percussion and String instruments. The program has three components: tuition, ensemble, and home practice. All three components are compulsory and are needed to be successful in this program.

Tuition takes place in school time, in small groups of 2-8 students on similar instruments and/or ability levels. The ensemble component is provided outside of school hours or during the lunch hour. Students are also required to practice their instrument at home to build their skills.

The Instrumental Music Program runs on a yearly enrolment agreement. Students are required to make a commitment to the program for the entire year. Semester reporting is provided to parents and students on levels of achievement and participation in the IM program.

The Instrumental Music teachers will be in contact at the start of each term with a student timetable, ensemble information and/or rehearsal times and locations.

- Participate in an appropriate ensemble and rehearsals, as designated by the teacher
- Participate in all concerts, performances and camps
- Develop a supportive attitude to other student s in lessons and ensembles
- Take all due care and responsibility for instrument/ s and property

PARENT AGREEMENT

- Provide a suitable instrument for your child, when required
- Pay levies or hiring fees as determined by the school
- Show interest in your child' s music studies and support and encourage them to learn
- Provide appropriate space and opportunities for practice
- Provide safe storage at home for instrument/s
- Keep instruments in good repair and service regularly
