## *Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths (STEM) Scholarship*

### **Everton Park State High School STEM Scholarship**

The STEM Scholarship recognises educational achievement in the area of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics for students in Year 7, 8 and 9. Everton Park State High School will award up to four Scholarships (valued up to a maximum of \$400 per year) to students in Year 7, 8 or 9. The STEM Scholars will be offered the role of Science Ambassadors for the school where they will work with our collaborative partners such as Queensland Academies, University of Queensland and Queensland University of Technology.

#### **Scholarship Funds**

- Scholarships are awarded up to a total maximum value of \$400 per year whilst in Year 7, 8 or 9
- Scholarship funds are intended to be used to support the recipient in undertaking curriculum studies at Everton Park State High School
- Recipients do not receive cash payments. The scholarship will cover the expenses of the curriculum timetabled to the student
- Subsequent curriculum expenses will be paid by the scholarship following confirmation of continued enrolment and evidence of successful results from the previous semester. Payments are capped to the maximum length of time necessary to complete Year 9 – not exceeding 3 years in duration or \$1200 in total funding
- Students who exit from Everton Park State High School will not receive any refund or financial payment from the Scholarship

#### **Eligibility**

Nominees must be students who:

- are enrolled as fulltime students at Everton Park State High School in either Year 7, 8 or 9
- are a permanent Australian resident
- maintain an “A” or “B” in most subjects during their enrolment at Everton Park State High School
- achieve a minimum attendance rate of 90% each year
- Achieve EPIC Awards for Effort and Behaviour

#### **Criteria for selection**

Nominations will be assessed against the following selection criteria:

- **Academic excellence**  
The high academic achievement of the nominee as indicated in school report cards and NAPLAN results
- **Community Support**  
A nomination / letter of support from the Principal of the attending school

## Information for Schools and Students

The following table outlines requirements of both nominating schools and student nominees.

### INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS

High achieving Year 6, 7 and 8 students should discuss their interest in being considered as the school's nominee for an *Everton Park State High School STEM Scholarship* with a relevant school staff member.

They should be able to clearly demonstrate to the selection panel, their:

- **Academic excellence**, including official school results and any academic awards
- **Outstanding leadership qualities**

This can include formal leadership positions such as School Captain, Vice-Captain, or House Captain, as well as those within community organisations or at events attended as an official representative of the school.
